Boyhood Home of President Woodrow Wilson Seeks Volunteer Docents

The Boyhood Home of President Woodrow Wilson is currently seeking applicants for its volunteer docent training program. Docent training will take place on Monday, March 30, 2009 from 10 a.m. until noon at the Joseph R. Lamar Boyhood Home located at 415 Seventh Street in downtown Augusta.

The Boyhood Home of President Woodrow Wilson, a National Historic Landmark, is located at 419 Seventh Street. Docents lead tours of the main house and service building, where the 28th President lived as a child during the Civil War and Reconstruction. Original and period furnishings appropriate to the 1860s decorate the home. Visitors include individuals and groups Tuesdays through Saturdays, from 10 a.m. through 5 p.m., and by appointment or for special events.
