Historic Augusta's Montgomery Receives Certification

On July 12, 2013 Erick Montgomery, Executive Director of Historic Augusta, Inc., received certification as a Historic Housing Development Finance Professional (HHDFP) from the National Development Council (NDC). HHDFP Certification is a professional credential given to individuals who successfully complete NDC's intensive historic real estate development finance training series. The training provides individuals working in the field of historic housing development with instruction in housing development finance, rental housing development finance including problem solving and deal structuring, and the creation and implementation of development programs.

The HHDFP Certification Program was presented in Salem, Massachusetts in September and in Knoxville, Tennessee in June. Upon successful completion of both courses and an exam, the candidate is awarded HHDFP Certification. The training was offered to historic preservation professionals through the National Trust for Historic Preservation's Partners Network, of which Historic Augusta, Inc. is a member. The training was funded, in part, by the 1772 Foundation of Pomfret Center, Connecticut, which supports the preservation of America's historical treasures.

The National Development Council was established in 1969 and is a non-profit organization specializing in economic and housing development training to over 60,000 professionals working in the fields of economic and housing development. Participants come from diverse backgrounds including city and state governments, public agencies, community-based organizations, professional organizations and banks.
