Wilson House Open for Tours Masters Week April 7-12, 2014

The Boyhood Home of President Woodrow Wilson will be open for tours on Monday, April 7 through Saturday, April 12, 2014. Guided tours will be offered on the hour from 10 am until 4 pm. On view will be the Civil War era main house, as well as a service building and carriage house, with original and period furnishings in which President Woodrow Wilson lived as a boy with his family.

The Boyhood Home of President Woodrow Wilson, a National Historic Landmark, is located at 419 Seventh Street in downtown Augusta, Georgia. It is owned and operated by Historic Augusta, Inc. as a house museum and tourist attraction. Tours of the museum are offered throughout the year on Thursdays, Fridays and Saturdays on the hour from 10 am until 4 pm. Group tours are offered by appointment.
