## **Wilson House Reopens March 27, 2014**

The Boyhood Home of President Woodrow Wilson will reopen for tours on Thursday, March 27, 2014 after having been closed for five weeks for plaster repairs. Generous grants were provided by the Knox Foundation and the Creel-Harison Foundation in order to complete this work. Still remaining will be repainting in the original documented colors after additional funds are raised.

The Boyhood Home of President Woodrow Wilson, a National Historic Landmark, is located at 419 Seventh Street in downtown Augusta, Georgia. It is owned and operated by Historic Augusta, Inc. as a house museum and tourist attraction. Guided tours are offered Thursdays through Saturdays on the hour from 10 am until 4 pm.
