Wilson House Open for Tours Masters Week April 4-9, 2016

The Boyhood Home of President Woodrow Wilson will be open for tours on Monday, April 4 through Saturday, April 9, 2016. Guided tours will be offered at the top of the hour from 10 am until 4 pm. On view will be the Civil War era home, as well as a service building and carriage house, with original and period furnishings in which President Woodrow Wilson lived as a boy with his family.

The Boyhood Home of President Woodrow Wilson, a National Historic Landmark, is located at 419 Seventh Street in downtown Augusta, Georgia. It is owned and operated by Historic Augusta, Inc. as a historic house museum and tourist attraction. In addition to Masters Week, regularly scheduled tours of the museum are offered throughout the year on Thursdays, Fridays and Saturdays on the hour from 10 am until 4 pm. Group tours are offered by appointment only.
