Celebrate Presidents' Day and View the New Exhibit at the Boyhood Home of President Woodrow Wilson February 19, 2018

The Boyhood Home of President Woodrow Wilson will be open for tours on Monday, February 19, 2018 in honor of Presidents' Day. Special Buy-One, Get-One Free tours will be given every 30 minutes on the hour and half hour between 10 a.m. and 4 p.m. Regular admission prices are \$5 for adults, \$4 for seniors, \$3 for students K-12, and free for children under age 5.

A ribbon cutting ceremony at 10:00 a.m. will commence the grand opening of *Woodrow Wilson*, the museum's newest permanent exhibit. Visitors to the museum will have the opportunity to explore this new exhibit and learn more about Wilson's formative years in Augusta, including the impact of his childhood experiences during the Civil War and Reconstruction on his later life and presidency.

Children will enjoy fun activities including crossword puzzles and coloring pages. See "A Boy Never Gets Over His Boyhood," a video about Wilson's life after Augusta prior to the guided tour of his Civil War era home.

The Boyhood Home of President Woodrow Wilson is located at 419 Seventh Street in downtown Augusta. In addition to Presidents' Day, The Boyhood Home of President Woodrow Wilson is open for tours during its regularly scheduled times Thursdays through Saturdays, on the hour from 10 a.m. through 4 p.m. Group tours are offered by appointment.
