Candlelight Tours of the Boyhood Home of President Woodrow Wilson to be held December 12, 2015

Special Candlelight Tours will take place at the Boyhood Home of President Woodrow Wilson on Saturday, December 12 from 5 – 7 pm, with tours offered every 30 minutes on the hour and half hour. The last tour will begin at 6:30 pm. To celebrate Woodrow Wilson's winter wedding to Edith Bolling Galt on December 18, 1915, the home will be decorated with fresh evergreens and a period Christmas tree. Tours will incorporate details about what Christmas might have been like during Wilson's first term as President of the United States and feature items from the couple's wedding including local newspaper articles, photographs, and announcements. Local harpist Dr. Alice Little Caldwell will perform holiday music during the tours. Festive refreshments will be served in the museum's visitors center, the ground level of the Joseph R. Lamar Boyhood Home next-door at 415 Seventh Street. Admission: \$5 for adults, \$4 for seniors, \$3 for students K-12, free for children under 5 years of age.
