Preservation Services Director Robyn Anderson will explain the process of buying and renovating historic buildings and how significant tax credits can reduce the cost of rehabilitation by half. Attendees will also learn about the Secretary of the Interior's Standards for Rehabilitation and will review a case study of a successful certified rehabilitation project.

The workshop will take place on Thursday December 15th, 2016, from 9:00 am until 12:00 pm at the Joseph R. Lamar Boyhood Home located at 415 Seventh Street in Augusta. **The cost is free for Historic Augusta members and \$20 for non-members.** Space is limited. Enjoy the house decorated for the holidays with fresh evergreens and festive decorations. Tours of the Boyhood Home of President Woodrow Wilson during the month of December will incorporate details about what Christmas was like during 1866, in the years following the Civil War.

A special **Candlelight Tour** will take place on **Friday, December 16 from 5 – 7 pm**, with tours offered every 30 minutes. See history come to life by candlelight! Festive refreshments will be served on the evening of the Candlelight Tour. **Candlelight Tour admission will be \$10 for adults, \$5 for students ages 5-18, or free for children under age five.**

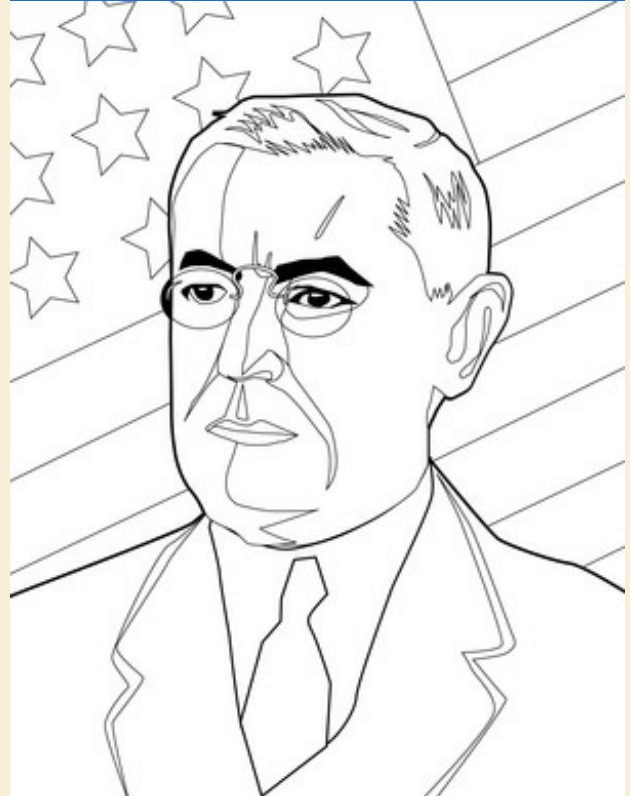

President Wilson's Birthday December 28, 2016



The Boyhood Home of President Woodrow Wilson will be open for tours on **Wednesday, December 28, 2015** in honor of the 28th President's 160th Birthday. Tours will be given on the hour between **10 a.m.** and **4 p.m.** Admission on President Wilson's birthday will be **buy-one, get-one of equal or lesser value free**.
