**Phase 2 Rehabilitation of
Rev. C. T. Walker House Complete**



***Rev. C. T. Walker House, 1011 Laney-Walker

Over the past year, Historic Augusta has been working to stabilize and preserve the **Rev. C. T. Walker House**, located at 1011 Laney-Walker Boulevard in the **Laney-Walker North Historic District**. This significantly endangered property had been vacant, unsecured, and suffering from deferred maintenance. **Phase 1** of the rehabilitation resulted in a new roof to make the house weathertight, and removal of the non-historic porte-

cochere. **Phase 2** has shored up the foundation and new foundation walls have been built. All exterior siding was removed, assessed, and new custom-milled wood siding was installed. All existing window sashes and openings have been covered with plexiglass to protect the property and allow natural light into the rooms. Thank you to **Capitalrise, LLC** who worked with us on both phases to meet preservation standards with the rehabilitation. The rehabilitation would not have been possible without the financial support of the **National Trust for Historic Preservation**, the **1772 Foundation**, the **Knox Foundation**, and the **Watson-Brown Foundation Junior Board**. We are grateful for the professional expertise of our C. T. Walker House Committee that has worked with limited resources to ensure the property was stabilized and for **2KM Architects**, which prepared the stabilization plans, proposed floorplans, and oversaw the construction work. We currently have the home listed for sale with **Geneice McCoy** of [Real McCoy Brokerage Company](#) and are eager to find a **preservation minded buyer** who will complete the remaining interior rehabilitation in consultation with Historic Augusta.

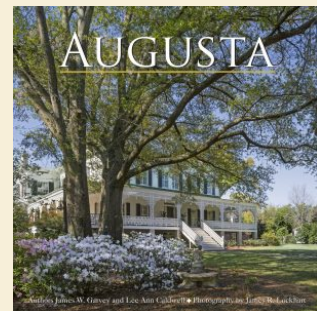


Architect's Rendering of the Augusta Jewish Museum

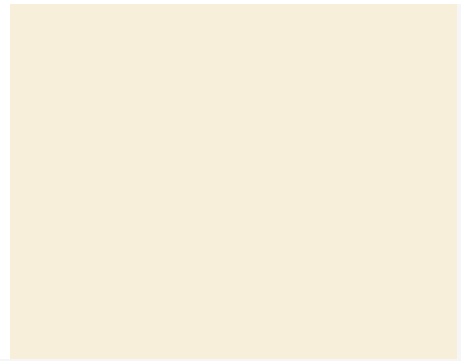
