Historic Courthouse Annex and Synagogue Update

Work has begun on the selective demolition of the non-historic additions to the old IT building and annex. This will bring the city's municipal complex up to fire code. Both the Synagogue and the Court of Ordinary buildings will remain for future use as a Jewish Museum. The partial demolition should be complete sometime this month.
