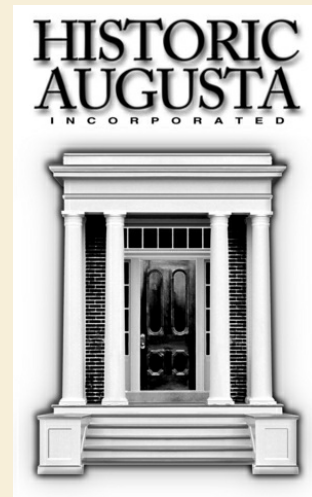

Our goal is to ensure the survival of Augusta's historic resources for future generations. **To nominate a property, please send an email with the address of the property, a photo, and description to Robyn Anderson, Preservation Services Director at [robyn@historicaugusta.org](mailto:robyn@historicaugusta.org)**

Criteria includes:

- The building is at least 50 years old and is eligible for listing on the National Register of Historic Places.
- The building should have an identified threat such as: vacancy, neglect, encroachment by development, or inappropriate alterations.
- The building should be historically or architecturally significant in its own right, or can be representative of a particular type or style.
