## Weatherization Tips for Your Historic Home



As the weather becomes cold and crisp, you may wonder about the energy efficiency of your historic home. The National Trust for Historic Preservation has excellent tips and guidelines to address questions homeowners have from insulation to windows to mechanical systems. You may also consider having an energy audit performed to pinpoint particular areas of concern and quickly resolve any issues you may have. You may be surprised to learn that your windows are typically not the culprits for those drafts you feel; often it is the seal around the window or doors! Interior storm windows can also help to cut down on your energy costs and allow original historic windows to remain intact.
