2014 Endangered Properties List to be Announced November 7th



Historic Augusta's Annual Endangered Properties List is slated to be unveiled at a press conference Thursday November 7th at 10:00am at 529 Greene Street, currently the offices of 2KM Architects.

The immediate goal of the list is to raise awareness about our community's historic assets, to educate the public about their historic, architectural, and cultural value. Properties that are typically listed are threatened by vacancy, neglect, demolition, encroachment by developments, or inappropriate alterations. Past properties documented by Historic Augusta include the Jacob Phinizy House, shown above, at 529 Greene Street. This former residence of Jacob Phinizy, was listed back in 2010 and today is placed back in service after several years of vacancy. The press conference is open to the public.
