**Virtual Downtown Loft Tour begins today, October 2nd**



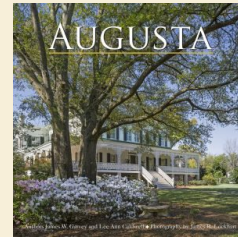

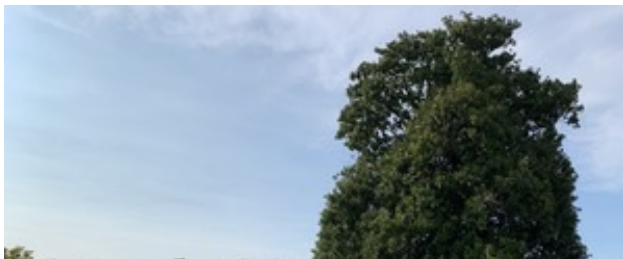
