Historic Augusta Receives Grant for Weatherization Project



Historic Augusta was recently awarded a grant from the National Trust for Historic Preservation's Richard and Julia Moe Fund for Statewide and Local Partners for \$10,000 to support Historic Augusta's Sustainability Demonstration Project. For this project, we will install interior storm windows on 41 windows and weatherize 44 windows and 5 doors throughout the Lamar House.

Historic Augusta will gather energy data from the last three years, perform an energy audit with Georgia Power, and log data after weatherization to demonstrate best preservation practices for organizations and homeowners. We will also self-produce short videos of interviews with the contractors talking with them about weatherization methods and showing how the work is completed that will be accessed thru our website. This project is also being funded by the Creel Harrison Foundation thru their grant of \$15,000. We look forward to beginning this project shortly and thank the generosity of our supporters.
